Predators Players to Meet Zoo Guests

Skate over to Nashville Zoo on Sept. 14 for Nashville Predators Day. From 1 – 5 p.m., Nashville Zoo’s Festival Field will be slammed with hard-hitting fun, including the chance to meet two Predators players.

Nashville Predators right wing Jordin Tootoo and newcomer Ryan Jones will be set up on Festival Field from 2 – 3 p.m. Tootoo, or “Toots,” established career highs in goals (11), assists (7) and points (18) during the 2007-08 season. Jones tied for second on the NCAA Division I all-time game-winning goals list (21).

Predators mascot Gnash and Zoo mascot Twiga will also be on Festival Field meeting guests. Games, including Slap Shot and Corn Hole, will be set up on the Field as well as several inflatables and a giant obstacle course. Nashville Predators Day is included with Zoo admission.
